

Post Oak Boulevard – North Segment Construction / San Felipe to 610

November 23, 2106

- The 12” water line on the southbound side of Post Oak Boulevard from IH-610 to Westbriar is completed. We are now testing the line.
- Connection of the storm system from north of Hollyhurst to the existing storm located along the east side of IH-610 continues at IH-610 and northbound Post Oak Boulevard.
- Manholes are going in near McDonald’s for collecting sanitary service.
- Sanitary sewer work continues from IH-610 to Hollyhurst on the northbound side of Post Oak Boulevard.
- Traffic signal work is going well. Signal timing continues to be monitored and modified to enable smoother traffic flow.
- Work progresses on the stainless steel arches by Four Oaks Office Complex and Willie G’s for the extensions needed to span the new Post Oak Boulevard.
- Trees in the median continue to be removed and relocated as we move further south on the Boulevard toward San Felipe.
- Finally, construction will be taking a short Thanksgiving holiday break, but necessary maintenance will continue in the area.
