

Post Oak Boulevard – North Segment Construction / San Felipe to 610

December 2, 2106

- The 12” waterline on the southbound side of Post Oak Boulevard from IH-610 to Westbriar has now passed the required City acceptance testing. Contractor is prepping for transfer of water services to the new waterline.
- Connection of the proposed storm sewer along the northbound lanes of Post Oak Boulevard to the existing storm sewer located along the east side of IH-610 should be completed by the end of this week.
- Work on the 24” sanitary sewer line from IH-610 to Hollyhurst continues and will mostly be completed by the end of next week.
- The widening of the roadway has begun along the northbound lanes of Post Oak Boulevard. The paving work in this section will continue to the end of the year.
- Work continues on extending the stainless steel arches by Four Oaks Office Complex and Willie G’s to span the new Post Oak Boulevard.
- Trees in the median continue to be removed and relocated as construction progresses further south along the Boulevard toward San Felipe.
- Centerpoint, AT&T and other contractors continue the adjustment and relocation work in the area.
- Construction activities will take a short holiday break between Christmas and New Year’s, but necessary maintenance will continue in the area.
