

Uptown Construction Update
January 26, 2018

Post Oak Boulevard – North Segment Construction / 610 to San Felipe

- Communication duct bank and primary electrical will continue to be installed in the median
- Driveway work will continue in the northbound lanes from Hollyhurst to I-610
- Storm sewer installation at Garrettson will conclude. Paving will follow
- Installation of sidewalks on the southbound side will continue

Post Oak Boulevard – Middle Segment Construction / San Felipe to Westheimer

- Installation of sanitary and storm sewer will continue in the northbound lanes from San Felipe moving south toward Westheimer. Following their installation, paving will begin
- Installation of trees will continue from Guilford north to Ambassador on the southbound side
- Installation of sidewalks will continue in front of Post Oak Central on the southbound side

Post Oak Boulevard – South Segment Construction / Westheimer to Richmond

- Concrete pavement removal will continue, then installation of base and new pavement on southbound lanes from West Alabama to Fairdale
- Installation of storm crossings and inlets will continue on southbound lanes from West Alabama to Hidalgo
- Pavement removal and replacement in northbound lanes will begin from West Alabama to Westheimer
- Storm and sanitary sewer installation will continue in northbound lanes from West Alabama to Westheimer
- Crosswalk between Dillard's and The Galleria is now permanently closed

Centerpoint, AT&T and other contractors continue the adjustment and relocation work in the area.
